1. DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TIFF PLAN —Tatman reported on the current Tiff Plan. Tiff plan dated 1986 was addressed in 1994 but amendments were never enacted. Currently the DDA is still operating under the 1986 plan which is outdated. The plan does not meet the criteria of the state requirements. Status of the plan has to be updated. A plan must be submitted the state by April 1, 2019. Changes have to be made to meet the state requirements. Smith Group, Planners working on the Village Master Plan, are capable of doing the Tiff Plan. Additional cost would be \$6,000-\$10,000.
