## **APPROVAL OF AGENDA:**

**MOTION** by Calamita, seconded by Mills to approve the agenda as amended adding #4 Town & Country Façade Grant and #5 Northshore Landscape Bill to Old Business.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Partaka notes we received a nice Thank You from Tom Regan's family.

**REVIEW OF FINANCIAL INFORMATION – (Hand out) –** Systerman explains the two uncleared items you see in the financial statements will be cleared next month. The auditors want it done a certain way. Systerman will do all the reports the auditors have asked for. Systerman will check with Agri Valley to make sure their bill is reduced for the winter months.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. **KLA UPDATE** – Partaka explains if the computer updates it shuts the music down. We are working on this issue. The new speakers are in. We do have an issue with one speaker. This speaker was placed on The Creamery but does not have electricity to it. Does the board want to take it down and save it for a replacement speaker or place it somewhere else? The board decided to keep it for a spare.

2. MOVIE NIGHT UPDATE – Partaka explains Melissa Anderson did not drop the invoice off yet. Does the board want to do this next year? Discussion follows.

3. PARKING LOT UPDATE – Partaka explains the parking lot is finished and looks great. Kaatz asked about guard rails. Partaka notes we are going to use boulders if needed instead of guard rails. The church donated some parking blocks but we will need an extra 17 parking blocks to finish it. Tatman notes Parks & Rec want to know if shrubs will be planted. Partaka explains we cannot plant shrubs along the road as the ditch is natural drainage.

**4. TOWN & COUNTRY FAÇADE GRANT** – Partaka explains all paperwork has been turned in for this façade grant. This has already been approved. We need to approve the pay out like we did for the other façade grants.

**5. NORTHSHORE LANDSCAPING** – Partaka explains we had two trees that died. The maintenance contract with Northshore has lapsed. Partaka approved \$500.00 to remove & replace the dead tree as well as feed the rest of the trees.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **TREE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT** – Partaka hands out two different maintenance contracts from Northshore Landscaping. The first one is for \$1,000.00 for one application per year, the second one is for \$1,800.00 for two applications per year. Discussion follows.

**MOTION** by Stencel, seconded by Calamita to approve \$1,800.00 (two applications) to Northshore Landscaping.

2. CHRISTMAS LIGHTS – Partaka explains Northshore Landscaping does our Christmas Lights each year. They do the tops of the buildings along M-25. They requested Coombs Dentist building be included this year as it is dark in that area. Partaka explains we could include Jeff's Market as well. The cost for the extra Christmas lights would be a few hundred dollars as they are commercial lights. Discussion follows.

MOTION by Systerman, seconded by Mills to purchase Christmas lights not to exceed \$450.00

**3. PURCHASE NEW CHRISTMAS RIBBON** – Partaka explains we need to purchase ribbon for the bows on the wreaths as well as wrapping the poles.
