LOW SPEED VEHICLE / ORV STICKER RENEWAL

Dear Resident,

According to our records, the Lexington Low Speed / ORV sticker that you have been issued is up for renewal. The cost of renewal will be as follows;

\$125.00 – Two year renewal

If your current issued sticker is still in good condition you may keep that original sticker; if the original issued sticker is damaged, faded, and/or non-existent – you must replace that sticker. There will not be any additional cost for a new sticker, you must simply request a new sticker at the time of renewal. You will be provided a receipt upon payment of renewal.

Slow Speed Safety Inspection Policy

Definitions -

"Low-speed vehicle" means any four-wheeled electric or gas vehicle whose top speed is greater than 20 miles per hour but not greater than 25 miles per hour, including neighborhood electric vehicles. Low-speed vehicles must comply with the safety standards set forth in this policy.

As used in this policy, except as otherwise provided, the term:

"Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that is designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for sporting or recreational purposes and that is not capable of exceeding speeds of 25 miles per hour.

Operation of a low-speed vehicle on certain roadways.--The operation of a **low-speed vehicle**, as defined on any Village street as defined, is **authorized** with the following restrictions:

- a. A low-speed vehicle may be operated only on streets **where the posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less**. This does not prohibit a low-speed vehicle from crossing a road or street at an intersection where the road or street has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour.
- b. A low-speed vehicle must be equipped with headlamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, tail lamps, brakes adequate to stop and hold the vehicle, windshield, parking brakes, rearview mirror, seat belts, horn, bumper and exhaust.
- c. A safety inspection conducted by the Lexington Police Department shall cost \$125.00 for two years and be completed on a police department inspection form. Safety Inspection stickers will be provided, issued and applied by the Lexington Police Department.
- d. Any person operating a low-speed vehicle must have in his or her possession a valid driver's license.

Operation of golf carts on Village roadways.--The operation of a **golf cart** upon the public roads or streets of this Village of Lexington is **prohibited** except as provided herein:

- a. A golf cart must carry a current safety inspection sticker issued by the Lexington Police Department.
- b. A golf cart may **not** be operated on public roads or streets by any person **under the age of 16**.
- c. A golf cart may be operated only during the hours **between sunrise and 1200am**.
- d. Operate far right of roadway and prohibited on sidewalks and bike path.

- e. A golf cart may be operated on a part of the State Highway System only under the following conditions:
 - a. To cross a portion of the State Highway System which intersects a Village Street.
 - b. Any infraction of the motor vehicle code or local ordinance, or this Policy: shall lead to restriction or revocation of the issued safety sticker. That determination shall be at the sole decision of the Lexington Police Department.
